



Door Keepers Solos

- You should report to the Contest Office at the time advised by the Volunteers Coordinator.
- Your role is to maintain and control the flow of audience members into and out of the room / auditorium.
- FREE ENTRY** is granted to competitors **ONLY** if they are appearing in the **FULL UNIFORM** of their band. The wearing of a Partial or casual uniform unless this is the uniform worn on stage for competition does not qualify to allow free entry.
- You will be required to check that tickets have been purchased prior to anyone entering to room/hall (children under 16 years are free).
- Please make yourself familiar with the appropriate ticket designs for the day in which you are working.
- You should **NOT** allow audience members in or out of the performance room/hall whilst a performance is in progress. You must allow entry **between** competitors.
- Door Keepers must close the door when a competitor is ready to play. The door keeper will remain outside the room while the competitor is playing and ask people outside to remain quiet whilst the performance is happening.
- You must allow the Contest Supervisor, Contest Co-ordination or Technology Manager to enter or exit the room/hall at any time.
- Should you have any queries or concerns that you cannot deal with directly, such as complaints, questions about rules or interpretations, or any other matter which cannot be simply answered, please refer them to either your room supervisor or the Contest Office.
- The other duty of the door keeper is to update the event number and competitor number listings on the door.
