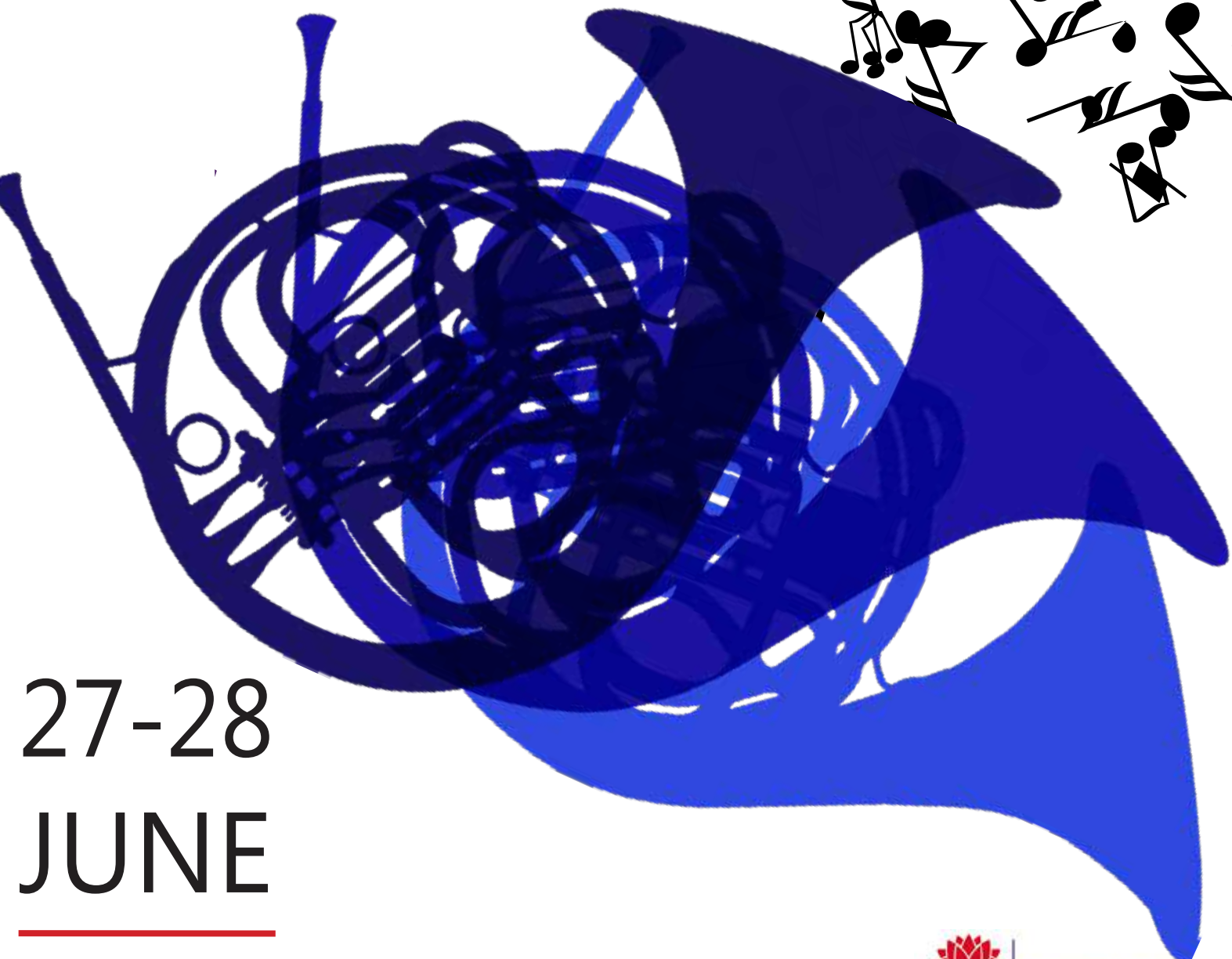

Meet our Adjudicators

Warwick Tyrrell

Warwick is one of Australia's most accomplished and inspirational musicians. Highlights of his extraordinary 30-year career include holding the position of Principal Trombonist with the London Philharmonic Orchestra, Outright Winner of the International Trombone Competition 1988 and has been a concerto soloist in South Africa, South Korea and the United Kingdom with The London Philharmonic and all over Australia with the Sydney, Melbourne, Queensland, Tasmanian and Adelaide Symphony Orchestras. He has also toured China and the USA as a soloist. Warwick has recorded concertos for Australia's biggest classical music recording company ABC Classics for CD release with The Adelaide Symphony which was described by Qantas Magazine as "the most exciting offering yet from the ABC Classics label".

In addition to his classical music, Warwick had a great love of musical theatre. He left The London Phil to study acting, singing and dancing. He was subsequently being offered two years full-time work in the Australian touring productions of Cabaret and Jolson, singing and acting nightly alongside pop icons Tina Arena and Lisa McCune as well as Music Theatre gurus Rob Guest and Judi Connelly. At the same time, Warwick ran a business which produced pop music singing, and dancing shows about personal safety in Primary schools all over Australia, performing to over 100,000 school-children and selling over 10,000 CDs.

Warwick is now a trained conductor, being awarded a Master in Orchestral Conducting in 2018 from



Sydney University. While there, he received the Peter Davidson Award – at \$25,000 one of Australia's most prestigious classical music awards. Warwick has conducted and compered education concerts for the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and conducted in regional work for the Queensland Symphony, as well as running his sold-out concert series in Sydney which presents a fantastic display of Community Bands to an 800 strong subscription audience. He was also the Musical Director of the Bankstown Carols, a community carols event which attracted an audience of around 10,000.

Warwick loves encouraging others in music, helping them to draw out of themselves things they never thought possible! He spends much time travelling as an adjudicator and music educator, working with choirs, orchestras and bands all over the country.

He recently began a significant new career path as Artistic Director of Music for Canberra (incorporating the Canberra Youth Orchestra) and is excited by chance to rebuild CYO into one of Australia's finest youth orchestras!

Brian Evans

is Principal Third Trumpet/Cornet in the Opera Australia Orchestra, of which he has been a member since 1975 (45 years) playing in every chair in the section in a vast repertoire of operas and ballets. He began his musical activities at age 7 on banjo mandolin and progressed to tenor horn when he joined The Sydney Boys' High School brass band (1966). He soon changed to cornet and soprano cornet, becoming principal cornet in year 9, leading it to national school band champions in 1971. He played tenor horn, soprano cornet and B flat cornet with Waverly Municipal Band for 12 years including a number of years as principal cornet during its heydays in the 1970's. His concert band experience includes solo cornet with Australia Army Band Sydney (aged 19), Sydney Concert Band and NSW Arts Unit ensembles. After leaving the army he benefited greatly as a member of the ABC National Training Orchestra and has played with most major orchestral ensembles in Sydney, including the SSO, ACO and Sydney Philharmonia.

An active soloist, Evans has performed throughout the world. He was a featured artist during the 2003, 2005, 2009, 2010, 2013 and 2016 ITG and 2008 China Trumpet Guild conferences and has performed as guest soloist with the Hornsby Girls High School touring band in China, Europe, USA and Japan as well as with the Honolulu Community Concert Band in their 2006 Sydney Opera House appearance. He has taught at several schools in Sydney, and maintains a private studio of around 15 students from beginner to post graduate I. As a clinician, Evans has presented classes in Japan, China (where he presented his lecture, "The Trumpet and Cornet in Western opera – an introduction") and USA and was artist in residence at the Brisbane Conservatorium of Music, Griffith University, in October 2016. He presented the lecture "Trumpet for the non-player" at the 2018 Music Education Conference for professional



development in music education as part of the NSW School Band Festival.

As a champion of new music, especially from Australia, Evans has been involved in many local, international and world premieres in numerous situations including through his chamber ensemble, Trio Australis.

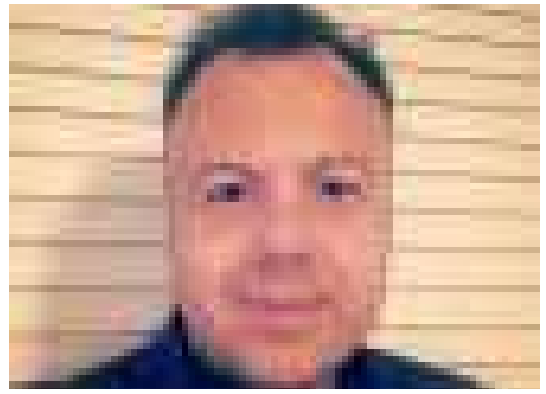
He has adjudicated at several school eisteddfod, was an adjudicator for the Asian International Trumpet Competition 2008 and in 2009 he was an adjudicator for the Ern Keller International Band of the Year competition.

After a 40 year hiatus, Evans returned to banding in 2018 as principal cornet for a concert with Pacific Brass and returned to contesting after a gap of 41 years, playing Solo Cornet with Australian national A Grade champions, Sydney City Brass. Brian is founding and current president of the Australian Trumpet Guild and served the International Trumpet Guild as a director for 18 years, including as President 2015-2017 and hosted ITG's annual conference in Sydney in 2010.

Joshua Hill

completed his undergraduate and post-graduate study at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music having also studied Korean traditional music at the National Gugak Centre in Seoul. Joshua is a core member of Australia's premier percussion ensemble SYNERGY PERCUSSION. He has performed and recorded with many of Australia's orchestras and ensembles including the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra, Australian Chamber Orchestra, Canberra Symphony, Ensemble Offspring, Symphony



Australis, Australian Baroque Brass, Taikoz, NSW Police Band and the Australian Air Force Air Command Band. Joshua has also been part of many recordings for ANIME, computer games and soundtracks for feature films.

Matt Klohs

is an Australian conductor, composer, clinician and adjudicator whose career has spanned almost 3 decades. He spent 17 years as a professional musician in the Royal Australian Navy Band before becoming a Band Officer and conductor in 2007. Since then, he has conducted professionally throughout Australia, the UK, the United States, and in Spain and continues to be in high demand. He has led performances by ensembles from world-renowned professional military bands to school ensembles, US college ensembles to beginner bands, and community bands of all levels. Matt has been Music Director of both the Melbourne and Sydney RAN Bands, as well as Senior Instructor at the Defence Force School of Music. His passion for the life-long journey of learning and teaching sees him maintain a busy schedule as a clinician and mentor working with musicians of all ages and experience levels while he studies a Master of Music Studies degree at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. His informative and positive adjudication style is regularly sought out with appearances at Festivals, Eistedd-



fodau and Contests throughout each year. He has adjudicated at Regional, State and National levels in Australia and more recently in New Zealand. Matt is proud to serve community bands and musicians as a member of the Bands Association of New South Wales Management Committee and as the NSW Delegate to the National Bands Council of Australia. He is a member of Music Advisory Boards in NSW and QLD and regularly provides repertoire advice to other groups around Australia.

Matt is a co-founder and Director of Maestros With A Mission Pty Ltd, a unique Australian company offering Professional Development, Print Music Publishing, Conducting Services, Adjudication and Consultancy to groups and individuals. He is also a published composer with numerous works available in Australia, the US and in Europe.

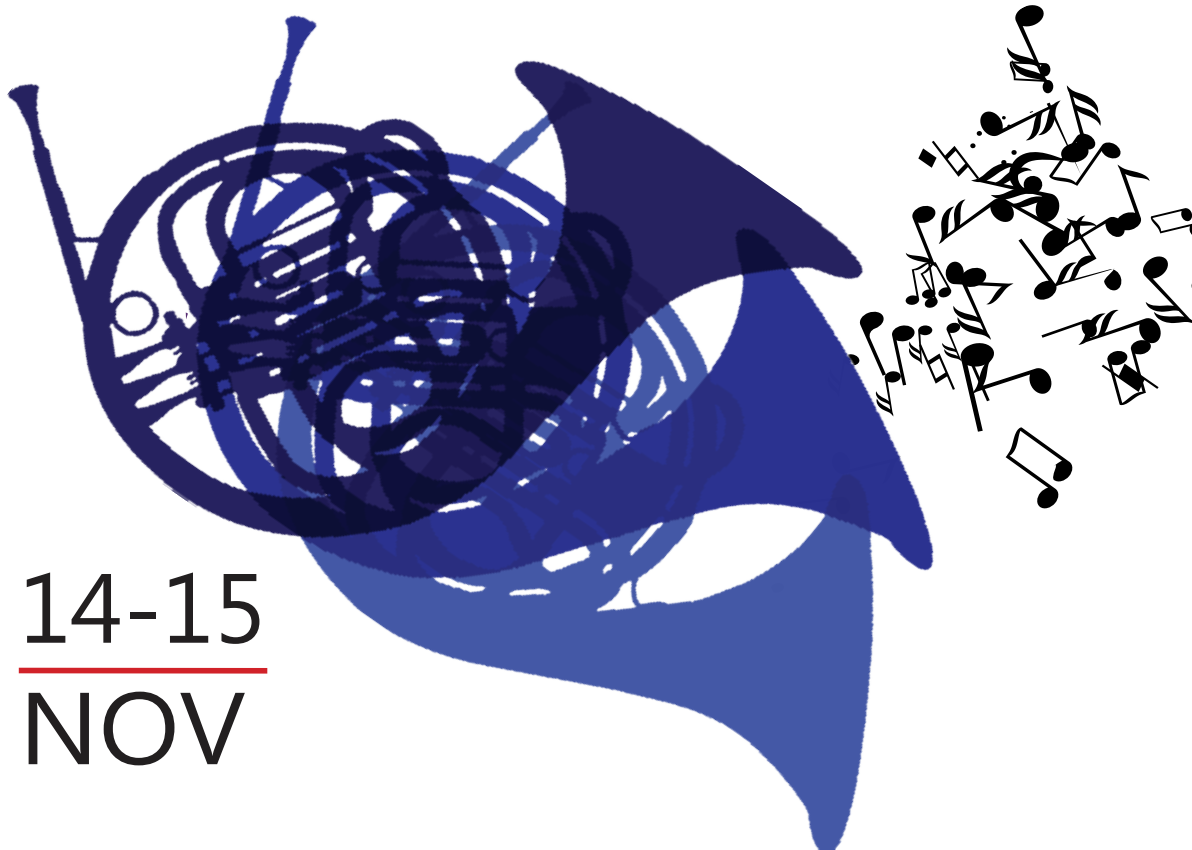
