From the Branch winners, the ultimate winner of the State Young Band Person of the Year is chosen by the Management Committee of the Band Association of NSW. The State award will be presented at the NSW State Band Championships.

The Sydney Metropolitan Band Branch plans to announce its winner at the Branch Solo and Ensemble Competition in May 2022.

Must be received no later than **Thursday 7th April 2022**

Only one nomination will be accepted from each band.

The nominated person must be 25 years of age or younger and a registered member of the band for at least one (1) calendar year as per the Band Association of New South Wales Constitution.

The musician who receives the Branch Award as 'Young Band Person of the Year' will be automatically nominated for the Band Association of New South Wales State Young Band Person of the Year Award.

The Award -

- All nominees will receive a Certificate
- The award winner will also receive a perpetual award with their name inscribed, together with a replica award. The perpetual award is retained for one year.

Criteria -

A nominee should satisfy some or all of the following;

- an attendance record of at least 80% for their band rehearsals and engagements over the past two years
- shown significant improvement in playing ability in the past twelve months
- performed in at least one Solo competition (Regional, State or National)
- positive contribution to their band's organisation and/or administration by undertaking tasks additional to just being a playing member
- consistent and positive interest at band rehearsals and engagements
- a good ambassador for their band and the band movement in their community
- assists other bands and/or has undertaken volunteer duties at community banding events
