Meet our Adjudicators



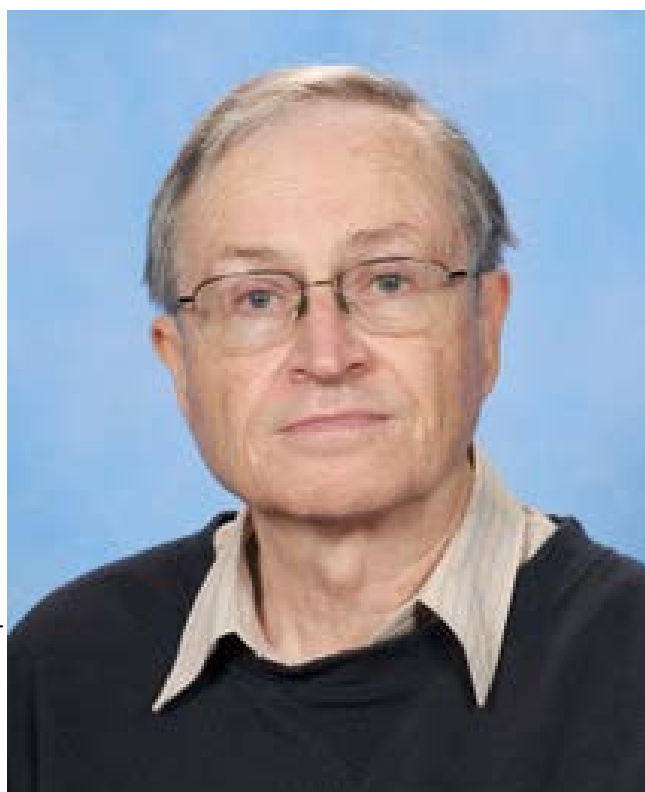
Robert Oetomo

Robert began his percussion studies at the age of 18 while commencing his Bachelor of Music (Composition) and Teaching degree at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music in 2006. The following year, he was admitted to the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, where he completed his Bachelor of Music (Performance) degree with First Class Honours in 2010. He then went abroad to Germany where he studied his Master of Music in Performance (Künstlerische Ausbildung) at the Staatliche Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst Mannheim (Mannheim University of Music and Performing Arts), receiving the highest distinction (1,0) for his graduation recital in 2014. His past teachers include Professor Dennis Kuhn, Jasmin Kolberg, Claire Edwardes, Daryl Pratt, Richard Miller and Gary Wain. Robert is an Encore Mallets Signature Artist, a Marimba One Premier Artist and a Sabian Cymbals endorser.

Michael Forsyth

studied composition with Eric Gross at the University of Sydney. His compositions have been performed, recorded and broadcast in Australia, China and Europe. His output includes choral, chamber, orchestral and brass band works. He studied tenor and bass trombone with Arthur Hubbard at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music gaining diplomas in performance and bandmastership. As a freelance musician, he has performed with many ensembles including the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra. Bass trombonist with the St. Mary's District Band from 1985 until 2006, he has been New South Wales Bass Trombone Champion on seven occasions as well as Australian National Champion three times

He has taught in government and private schools and is regularly called upon to adjudicate at Eisteddfodau and State and Metropolitan Band Competitions.





Dominic Longhurst

Dominic Longhurst is a 24 year old musician from Sydney, Australia. Growing up, Dominic loved any opportunity to perform, and is one Australia's most successful brass soloists in competitions, winning over 100 first prizes at metropolitan, state and national level. In 2011, Dominic was the recipient of the Dame Adrienne Stewart Bursary, which awarded him the opportunity to study under Professor David King. Very shortly after, as a 13 year old, Dominic won both the Australian, and New Zealand National under 19 Brass 'Champion of Champions' - In over 100 years of the contest, this has still never been achieved by anyone else. Following this, Dominic won the junior and open cornet sections at the National Brass Championships of Australia, and went on to win both Junior and Open brass finals in 2013, at the age of 15, becoming the only person in the competitions history to hold both crowns in the same year.

In 2015, Dominic moved to the UK to study trumpet at the Royal Northern College of Music (RNCM) and subsequently joined the Brighouse and Rastrick band where he held the positions of Principal Cornet and Soprano Cornet for nearly 4 years. Dominic quickly gained a reputation as a world class cornet soloist from performances given in contests and concerts given across the globe. In that time, Dominic represented England and Norway at the European Brass Band Championships on four occasions, and also played part in winning the National Championships of Great Britain with the Brighouse and Rastrick Band in 2017. Having moved back to Australia, Dominic took on the Musical Director role of the Willoughby Band, is Principal Cornet of Pacific Brass, and performs as a freelance musician with Opera Australia and is the 2022 recipient of the Sydney Symphony Orchestra trumpet fellowship.

Jocelyn Fazzone

Jocelyn Fazzone is a Sydney based flutist, pianist, educator and examiner. Jocelyn currently teaches at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music and UNSW, she is Woodwind Advisor/Chief Examiner and Federal Examiner with the AMEB NSW, and founding member of Windfall Sextet and Flute-worthy publications. She has received 14 AMEB teaching awards to date for achieving the top annual student examination results in NSW. Jocelyn is a published author of flute music collections and teaching reference material, and has recorded a number of CDs featuring Australia's leading flutists, including Janet Webb.

Jocelyn is frequently featured as guest performer, master class teacher, lecturer & teaching mentor around Australia. She has recorded for Fine Music and ABC radio, and has worked as orchestral flutist with a number of major orchestras, including the SSO, AOBO, QSO & TSO.

Ken Bradley

With great sadness, we note the passing of BANSW Life Member Ken Bradley. Ken had been battling cancer for several years now and unfortunately passed in the small hours on Wednesday, 25 May.

Over the 120 years of the formation of the Band Association of New South Wales, there have been many champions who have won numerous championships and have outstanding credentials, but without doubt none to challenge these of Ken Bradley and Brian McGuiness. We are honoured to share an article published in The Music Stand in September 2019 detailing Kens record of achievements in banding.



Ken's first band, the Black Town District Junior, conducted by Bill Soames, had a huge influence on his future success. At an early age, it was obvious that Ken was something special future ahead of him. A brilliant exponent of the tenor horn, he had an impressive and somewhat enviable career as a soloist.

NSW Championships. In 1973, commencing competition at the age of 10, Ken won his first NSW state Junior Championship and successfully defended it to 1980 (plus 3C of C titles). In 1974 at the age of 11, he also competed in the Open section and created a record that still stands today as the state ever youngest Open champion. In 1975, Ken placed second in brackets (open event) but regained the title in 1976. And subsequently held both the Junior and Open titles until 1980. Ken carried on his winning way to 1987, giving him 12 consecutive open titles and in 1979 and 1980 held the rare distinguish of winning both the Junior and Open Champion of Champions. In 1985, Ken was appointed Musical Director of the Saint Marys Band District Band and made fewer solo appearances but had wins at State level in 1990 and 1993 (plus C of C) 1998 and 2000. Relinquishing his position as Musical Director of the band, in 2006, Ken joined its ranks playing the Eb base. He won the State Eb Bass Championship in 2011 to 2013 and 2017 and completed a double by also winning the Bb Bass Championship state titles (31 state titles and 8 C of C).

Australian National Championships. Ken won 3 Junior titles 1975, 1977 and 1980, age 12. He is the youngest to win an Open National Solo Championship. He won his first Junior and Open Championship in 1977, then followed with the consecutive wins from 1980 to 1987 inclusive (plus C of C 1982 and 1983] and again 1994 - 1996 – 1999- 2003 and 2004, Eb wins in 2001 - 2004 and 2011. In total 21 Nationals titles and 2 Champion of Champions.

National British Open Championships. Having just turned the age of 16 in 1978, Ken was invited to compete in the British Open Solo Championships and took his place in a field of hopefuls, playing Helen Johnstons 'Endevour'. He was awarded 198 points and the British Open Tenor Horn Championship title, which qualified him for the final and to be placed second. He was passionate and responsible for the organisation of the Ern Keller International Soloist of the Year and qualified on 7 occasions.

Ken was a playing member of Warringah Concert Brass and Conductor of the Bankstown City band.
