



Registrars for Bands

- Please report to the Contest Office at the venue at the time advised to you by the Volunteers Coordinator.
- Your role is to ensure that all competing band members entering into the warm-up room are registered members of the Band Association of NSW. Only those people confirmed as members may proceed beyond the warm up room.
- Please familiarise yourself with the people who you are working with, particularly the Contest Supervisor and the Contest Coordinator and the Associations Registrar.
- Beyond your point is a secure area. Only the Contest Supervisor, the Contest Coordinator or authorised members of the BANSW Contest Committee or Management Committee or confirmed playing members of the bands which are either on stage, in, or going into the warm-up room are permitted.
- You will be supplied with either sign-on or registration sheets for all bands plus permits in the particular room/hall that you have been assigned.
- All registered players, conductors and permits may be required to either sign a sign-on sheet or verbally confirm their name with this being ticked on the provided registration sheet prior to entering the warm up room. The completed sign-on and registration sheets are to be returned to the Contest Office at the conclusion of the day.
- If a player in a band does not appear on the list, immediately advise the Contest Supervisor or the BANSW Registrar. Allow the person through to warm-up with the band whilst the situation is rectified or a determination on the eligibility for that player to continue participation is made.
